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Block Method

I. Introduction

- Introduce the topic and provide background information
- State the purpose of the essay and the topics to be discussed

II. Topic A

- Present the first topic or idea in a block of text
- Provide relevant information, evidence, and examples
- Use transitional devices to guide the reader through the content

III. Topic B

- Present the second topic or idea in a separate block of text
- Provide relevant information, evidence, and examples
- Use transitional devices to guide the reader through the content

IV. Comparison or Contrast

- Compare and contrast the two topics or ideas directly
- Highlight similarities and differences between them
- Use clear and concise language to make a compelling comparison or contrast

V. Conclusion

- Summarize the main points of the essay
- Restate the purpose of the essay and the significance of the comparison or contrast
- Provide a closing statement that leaves a lasting impression on the reader
